## Generic Baccalaureate Program - Blackwood - Plan of Study

Rutgers, The State University of New Jersey, School of Nursing, has collaborated with Camden County College in Blackwood, NJ to provide an opportunity to obtain a Bachelor of Science Degree in Nursing after completing an Associate's Degree in Science - Pre-Nursing Track.

Students applying to the program must have either an Associates of Science degree or sixty (60) undergraduate pre-requisite credits from Camden County College.

- The opportunity to complete all coursework on the Camden County College - Blackwood campus
