



Post-Bacc DNP Women's Health Nurse Practitioner Program

The Post-Bacc Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) Women's Health Program is based at the Rutgers Health Sciences Campus in Newark, NJ. Graduates are eligible for certification to practice as a Women's Health Nurse Practitioner in the State of New Jersey with prescriptive authority.

Role and Qualifications: The Advanced Practice Nurse in Women's Health has a Doctor of Nursing Science (DNP) degree and advanced preparation in the assessment and management of changing health patterns in women across the life span.

Scope of Practice: The Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) in Women's Health prepares graduates to be practice leaders at the highest level in the application and translation of evidence based research to improve systems in healthcare for women. The DNP emphasizes advanced leadership and expertise to challenge the standards of practice and create innovative models of care.

Curriculum: The Post-Bacc DNP Women's Health Program is 68-credits with 630 clinical hours devoted to precepted NP practice and 500 mentored hours in which the student develops, implements, evaluates, and disseminates their DNP project. The program can be completed in part-time or full-time study. The following are the required courses for this program:
