



Masters in Leadership - Management Program

The Masters in Nursing Leadership - Management builds upon the foundation of baccalaureate education. This program is designed to incorporate the ongoing changes in the healthcare system. The Essentials of the Master's Education in Nursing, QSEN, and the AONE competencies are embedded in this program.

Role and Qualifications: Students in this program come from varied roles from staff nurse to nurse executive and across varied settings to include practice, academia, and industry. Students develop skills and knowledge needed to evolve the healthcare system. Students completing this program are prepared to take the leadership certification exams offered through ANCC or AONE.

Scope of Practice: Graduates with a master's degree in nursing are prepared for new and innovative roles across settings. This program is designed so that students who complete their Masters do not have to repeat courses but build on this foundation to complete their DNP if desired. Applications accepted Fall and Spring.

Curriculum: The Masters in Leadership - Management Program is 42 credits with 500 mentored hours. These practicum hours are integrated in both the theory courses as well as practicums. The program is a hybrid program in that the core courses, supplemental courses and theory courses are offered on-line. Applications are accepted Fall and Spring.
