Management of Health Data must be taken <u>before</u> DNP Capstone Project Planning & Proposal Development; and Clinical Inquiry & Evidenced Based Practice must be taken <u>before</u> Management of Health Data. Implementation courses are taken the final 2 semesters. In addition to the successful completion of the above course requirements, all DNP students must meet all the DNP project requirements set forth by the program (see <u>DNP Project Requirements document</u>). Additionally, the students who do not complete their projects during the project related courses will be required to register for a 1 credit-Project Continuation course for the subsequent semesters until project completion.
