- For professional registered nurses who wish to be certified in school nursing (instructional certificate) in the State of New Jersey.
- Provides RNs with the appropriate educational background, experiences and competencies to carry out the responsibilities and functions of the school nurse.
- A post-baccalaureate certificate program for registered nurses with a BA, BS or BSN

Candidates for the School Nurse Certification must:

- Hold current CPR and AED Certification
- Complete training in airway management and in the use of nebulizers and inhalers.

Curriculum

Foundational/Prerequisite Courses (7 credits)

(For nurses with a BS/BA in another field.) Equivalent courses earned while obtaining licensure as a registered professional nurse with a BS/BA or BSN degree can be applied to these course requirements. These courses can be undergraduate courses.

A minimum of 12 credits must be taken at Rutgers School of Nursing to obtain this certificate; otherwise there is no limit on transferred credits for certification purposes.
