

RU Cleared? How Can I Check?

CHECKLIST- TRADITIONAL AND SECOND DEGREE

- All Health and Immunization including Flu Vaccination must be on file in Student Health**
 - Check your Health and Immunization status via the **Patient Immunization Portal** at <https://patient-rbhs.medicatconnect.com> with your Rutgers NetID and password. For questions regarding Health/Immunization please contact Student Health Services via secure email through the Patient Immunization Portal <https://patient-rbhs.medicatconnect.com>

- Background Check completed in CastleBranch**
- Student Disclosure Form completed in CastleBranch**
- Urine Drug Screening completed in CastleBranch**
 - Log on to **CastleBranch** <https://www.castlebranch.com> and check on the status and expiration dates of your **Background Check, Student Disclosure and Urine Drug Screening**. Contact CastleBranch regarding errors, etc.

- Current American Heart Association CPR/BLS Card submitted to Canvas**
 - Review your CPR Card and make sure that it is valid for the entire course of your program while you are in clinicals
 - Only American Heart Association BLS CPR cards are accepted. If you do not have a valid American Heart Association BLS CPR card please schedule a training prior to the beginning of your clinical experience.
 - Your BLS CPR card is valid for two years and must remain valid throughout the course of your clinical experience each term you are enrolled in the program.
 - Log on to Canvas (clinical clearance course) <https://onlinelearning.rutgers.edu/canvas> under the “**School of Nursing - Student Information**” with your NetID and password and make sure your valid CPR card is uploaded to Canvas.

- Student Notification of Program Requirements submitted to Canvas**
 - Log on to Canvas (clinical clearance course) <https://onlinelearning.rutgers.edu/canvas> under the “**School of Nursing - Student Information**” with your NetID and password, module **Student Notification of Program Requirements Form**. Please read and sign uploaded form to Canvas starting
 - All students are required to complete and sign the **Student Notification of Program Requirements Form**. This form is a contract between the student and the School of Nursing which outlines some of the key expectations of the clinical experience (please note that other rules and regulations will be provided throughout the program).
