



**Title: Nurse**

**Reports to: Head Nurse and Director of Camp Uncommon**

General Summary

Camp Uncommon is seeking a Nurse to help oversee all aspects of the Camp Uncommon Health Center. Reporting to the Head Nurse and the Director of Camp Uncommon and working closely with Health Center Staff, contracted nurse practitioners and camp doctors, and Camp Uncommon Senior Staff, the Nurse is responsible for ensuring the health, wellness and safety of Camp Uncommon campers and staff members. We pay a competitive salary and offer many other enticing benefits, such as free room, board, and laundry service. Please do not worry about having in-state credentials; as long as you have a certification in any state, you are eligible to begin work at Camp Uncommon. We will pay for your state certification as soon as you begin at camp. The dates are 6/15/20-8/11/20.

Camp Uncommon serves ~750 campers from Uncommon Schools (grades 4-9) over 3 two-week sessions during the summer. At Camp Uncommon, we believe that an overnight summer camp experience:

1. Provides an opportunity for campers from Uncommon Schools to explore, learn, and have fun in a safe, tight-knit community;
2. Increases campers' social, emotional, and non-cognitive skills (e.g., self-confidence, responsibility, independence, and curiosity), which are essential to college and life success;
3. Provides a tremendous summer job opportunity/experience for Uncommon alumni and rising 12<sup>th</sup> graders from Uncommon Schools; and
4. Creates an additional pipeline for strong, diverse teacher candidates for Uncommon by providing a space for counselors (potential teachers) to work directly with Uncommon students.

Camp Uncommon offers the following program activities for campers:

- *Athletics*: soccer, flag football, basketball, tennis baseball, kickball, street hockey;
- *Waterfront*: swim instruction, general swim, sailing, kayaking, canoeing;
- *Adventure*: nature, overnight camping, climbing, and low ropes;
- *Inter-Arts*: arts & crafts, pottery, theater, dance, music;
- *STEM*: rocketry, natural/environmental science;
- *Discovery*: self-reflection, journaling, team-building; and
- *Intensives*: improvisation, photography, puppeteering, cooking, chess, spoken word, hiking, wacky sports, African dance, step dance, and yoga.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

Camp nurses are responsible for the health, wellness, safety, and care of all members of the Camp Uncommon community as well as related administrative duties. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

1. Administering camper prescription medications as directed;
2. Dispensing over-the-counter medications as appropriate;

3. Assessing campers and staff who are ill or injured and determine if further medical attention is needed;
4. Assisting in stabilizing campers and staff requiring transportation to medical facilities;
5. Contacting parents of ill or injured campers and staff (if appropriate) and updating them as necessary;
6. Documenting all injuries and care rendered. This involves documentation of all over-the-counter medicines, first aid treatment, and communication with parents, doctors/nurse practitioners or any other off-camp facilities;
7. Maintaining inventory of supplies;
8. Keeping the Health Center clean and organized; and
9. Working directly with all Health Center staff and nurses.

#### Qualifications

- A minimum of 1 year of nursing in a professional setting
- All necessary credentials and certifications
- Experience working with elementary and middle school students (grades 4-9) is preferred but not required
- Experience working in a summer camp setting
- Very strong organizational skills
- A tremendous work ethic
- An obsessive attention to detail and follow-through
- Ability to thrive in a fast-paced, entrepreneurial, performance-oriented environment
- Ability to communicate with families
- A personality and character that exudes flexibility, trustworthiness, creativity, energy, inspiration and positivity
