▪ Nursing Leadership

Designed for master's prepared nurses, this program equips students to effectively lead health care organizations toward better outcomes. The program can be pursued as a 3-year or 4-year plan of study, and features online courses, as well as in-person classes held at our Newark campus.

▪ Executive Weekend Model

This practice-focused DNP is designed for working, master's-prepared nurses and built to accommodate a full-time work schedule. Students meet in person, on our Newark campus, over one long weekend per month.
