## **Immunizations**

- Rutgers Health Sciences sets an immunization policy based on:
  - CDC guidelines
  - NJ State law

#### SHS

- Tracks and administers immunizations
- Works together with your school to ensure immunization compliance





## Immunization categories...briefly

- Category 1
  - Clinical students
  - Exposed to patients (and vice-versa)
- Category 4
  - Classroom
  - Exposed to classmates (and vice-versa)
- Web only
  - Immunizations recommended but not required


Students must complete immunization requirements before enrollment.

Students cannot wait for clinical rotations.





#### Select your immunization category and packet






## Immunization packet

- Fill out the packet
- Give to your healthcare provider to complete
- Upload with supporting documentation (labs, imaging) onto the portal at

https://patient-rbhs.medicatconnect.com/

Follow the directions on the portal





#### Submitting immunization information

- Secure portal for submitting information:
  - https://patient-rbhs.medicatconnect.com/
- Items that need to be submitted
  - Forms completed by a healthcare provider
    - Immunization Form
    - Additional immunization documentation (lab reports, etc.)
  - Mandatory Health Form completed by student online
  - Immunization dates entered by student

Review and verification takes up to 3 business days after we receive the documents.



## **Notifications**

- We send emails and texts every time immunization records are updated
- Emails are sent to Rutgers email accounts
- Texts are sent to the mobile on file
- Look out for messages from <u>noreply@medicat.com</u>
- We may occasionally send a personalized secure message
  - You'll be notified by email that you have a secure message on the portal
  - Click on the emailed link to be routed to the secure portal
  - Click on the messages tab to read your message

# Verified Compliance means that...

- All **baseline** immunization requirements have been met
- Additional annual requirements:
  - Flu vaccines
    - required in the fall for Category 1 students
    - Students with severe egg allergies may receive the egg-free vaccination
  - Tuberculosis screening
    - At matriculation, category 1 students must provide a 2-step PPD or TB blood test
    - Cat 1 students who had a positive tuberculosis test will need to complete a symptom questionnaire on the portal annually
    - Category 4 students are only required to provide a single step PPD if at higher risk for TB (as defined by the CDC).

Please upload that documentation onto the portal every year.

# Non-compliance can mean that...

- A required form is missing
- An immunization or titer is missing
- An incorrect lab test is provided
- Documentation is incomplete

If you have received an email of non-compliance and are unclear about the reason, send us a secure message on the <u>portal</u>.



#### **COVID-19 Testing for Category 1 Students**

- For students who are required to submit COVID-19 PCR tests, please upload them to the Patient Portal as a "COVID-19 Test Result" in the dropdown.

#### **Common Questions**


- "I am not immune to Hepatis B and my doctor gave me a booster already. Do I need to do anything else?"
  - Ensure you have provided the following required documents:
    - Quantitative HepB surface antibody titer
    - HepB surface antigen
    - Documented proof of the first dose of the HepB series
- "I was born in another country and received the BCG vaccine.
   I always test positive. Do I need to provide a PPD or TB blood test?"
  - Students with a history of BCG vaccination are not exempt from the TB testing requirement.
  - Submit documented proof of the positive PPD or TB blood test
  - Chest x-ray OR TB blood test report from the last 6 months
