The **OOH Nurse Residency Program** is a 12-month program designed to promote nursing careers in non-hospital settings. There is no tuition cost to the nurse resident.

This program assists **new graduates** in finding work in non-hospital settings and provides on-going support throughout the first year of employment.

The **OOH Nurse Residency Program** offers new graduates the knowledge and tools to transition from student life to a career in non-hospital settings.
