The Program is nationally accredited by the *Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education* (CCNE), which is a voluntary peer review process that assures the Nurse Residency Program meets the highest quality standards.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Nurses who meet the following criteria are eligible to participate:

- First nursing role
- Graduated from a prelicensure nursing program that is accredited
- Valid RN licensure in the state of employment
- Willingness to participate in learning seminars over the twelve-month program
