#### **Your Rights**

 To be free from discrimination in educational programs & activities receiving Federal financial assistance.

 To be protected in connection with any education-related activities on-campus or off-campus.

To have complaints investigated and addressed.

 At Rutgers we believe in a safe, supportive environment where you can live, learn, work, and collaborate



#### **Our Responsibilities**

 Train staff, faculty, students on how we contribute - either by what we do or what we don't do

Respond to complaints of sexual misconduct regardless of circumstances

Investigate reports, conduct hearings as necessary, impose sanctions when warranted



#### **VAWA**

#### Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Amendment

now includes stalking, dating violence and domestic violence

#### "Prompt, fair, and equitable" proceedings

- Adviser of their choice, or we can provide
- Simultaneous written notice



#### **Prohibited Behaviors**

- Sexual Harassment
- Gender-Based Harassment
- Sexual & Relationship Violence
- Stalking
- Sexual Intimidation
- Sexual Exploitation
- Retaliation



#### Climate Survey - 2020

Broad distribution across racial/gender lines

High response rate: 23.3% (n=384)

Similar responses to other STEM schools

#### Climate Survey - 2020

- 30% harassment by faculty/ students
- 77%(F) 84%(S) not serious enough to report
- 23% believed nothing would be done
- +31% was a witness, did nothing
- +16% aware of Title IX
- +34% aware of VPVA



#### How can you help?

- Respect all members of Rutgers community
- Come forward if you see/encounter something
- Consider your words and behavior
- Ask for consent in interpersonal relationships



#### Consent is...

# Freely given & informed

- clear and unambiguous communication
- individuals willingly and knowingly engage

# Affirmative (YES)

- cannot be given by someone incapacitated
- not gained from silence or absence of resistance

#### Specific

- one activity/occasion/person does not imply consent to others
- can be withdrawn at any time



#### Who can help you?

# Required Reporter

- OBLIGATED to report prohibited behaviors
- Faculty, admin, coaches, ombudsman, staff, etc.

### Confidential Resource

- NOT OBLIGATED to share personally identifiable info
- VPVA office, clergy, Student Wellness/other mental health professionals, Health Services physicians



#### How do I report an incident?

- Reporting Form\*:
  - compliance.rutgers.edu/title-ix/
- \*can be anonymous

- Tell someone you trust. Ask for help.
- No time limit to reporting.



#### Will there be an investigation?

An investigation depends on:

- 1. information shared by reporting party
- 2. preference of complainant
- 3. repeat offenders; and
- 4. imminent threat of danger.

#### **Prevention** Training

- Mandatory web-based program
- Topics include:
  - Consent
  - Sexual Assault
  - Gender Harassment
- Required of all new RBHS students
- Information sent to RU email account
