Please note, outstanding coursework must be completed and grade replaced with the grade earned within 12 months (regardless of enrollment status). Students who have not completed DNP Project Course requirements (those who have an IP grade) will be required to register for a 1-credit "Project Continuation" course each semester until the course grade is changed and the student is able to progress in the program or complete the project. BS to DNP programs must be completed in their entirety within six (6) years of admission.
