Saint Peter's University Hospital offers a paid 10-week Nurse Extern Program that is geared towards supporting and enhancing the clinical skills of junior and senior nursing students as they prepare to transition to practice.

Nurse externs will work alongside our expert clinical nursing team who will aid in providing hands-on skills and simulation activities for each extern. The shift schedule is three (3) 12-hour shifts per week, including working every other weekend.

Day Shift: 7 am - 7 pm

Night Shift: 7 pm - 7 am
