The minimum number of combined clinical practicum and DNP project experience hours is 1,000. Many students, however, may be required to complete more than 1,000 hours to meet minimum competency requirements for graduation and certification (when applicable).

Students unable to complete DNP Project courses may be offered an In-Progress (IP) grade. Please note, outstanding coursework must be completed and the IP replaced with the grade earned within 12 months (regardless of enrollment status). Students who have not completed DNP Project Course requirements (those who have an IP grade) will be required to register for a 1-credit "Project Continuation" course each semester until the course grade is changed and the student is able to progress in the program or complete the project. BS to DNP programs must be completed in their entirety within six (6) years of admission.
