4. Policy

Leave of Absence from the Nurse Anesthesia Specialty Track will be granted at the discretion of the Dean of the School of Nursing only to a student in good academic standing, who is not on academic or clinical probation, has not received an unsatisfactory grade of C+ or less, and is maintaining averaged grades of 80% or higher in all currently enrolled courses. Leave of Absence will only be granted for documented illness, injury or personal emergency beyond the control of the student that makes continuance in the program unreasonable. Leave of absence from the Nurse Anesthesia Specialty Track is limited to a single occurrence not to exceed twelve months in total.

5. Procedure

Students are to follow the procedure for requesting leave of absence outlined in the School of Nursing Handbook.
