4. Policy

The program limits students' measurable commitment to the program to a reasonable number of hours to ensure patient safety and promote effective student learning. Measurable student time commitment includes: the hours spent in class, all clinical hours, and any hours of outside employment. The sum of these hours may not exceed 64 hours in any week. Students must have a minimum of an 8 hour rest period prior to scheduled clinical assignments. The student is expected to report for all clinical assignments well rested, alert, unimpaired and prepared to deliver safe patient care.
