4. Policy

The anesthesia specialty track is offered only on a full time basis with as many as six courses in a semester. If approved by both the Program Director and the Dean of Graduate Studies, a student may withdraw from all courses taken during one semester without penalty of dismissal from the School of Nursing. Approved withdrawal from multiple courses is limited to one instance and must be associated with either an approved leave of absence or transfer to another specialty track.
