Note: Final graduation rates are based on the SON Division of Advanced Nursing Practice policies for on time graduation and total length of time in the doctoral program (4 or 5 years) and post master's certificate program (2 years). Where data is not available students in these cohorts are still enrolled and working towards completion. Data will be posted as is available. Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, students in all programs experienced significant interruptions that have resulted in extended time for program completion or program transfer or attrition. This was especially impactful for the cohort matriculating in 2019.
