#### 1. Policy Statement

This policy clarifies the School of Nursing's policy on religious accommodation for students whose classes or clinicals fall on a day of religious observance.

### 2. Reasons for Policy

To provide students with guidance on when and how to request religious accommodation.

### 5. The Policy

Rutgers University is committed to fostering a community that supports students, faculty and staff of all faiths. It is the policy of the University not to cancel classes on religious holidays. Rather, the University provides reasonable accommodations for students to enable them to exercise their sincerely held religious beliefs unless the accommodation would impose an undue hardship on the university.

#### Absence Due to Religious Observance

It is the policy of the university to excuse without penalty students who are absent because of religious observances and to allow the makeup of work missed because of such absences. Absences for reasons

of religious obligation will not be counted for reporting purposes. Alternatives will be provided to students who are not able to attend a class, examination, clinical, laboratory, or other required activity due to religious observance.

#### **Religious Accommodation**

Religious observance is one of the recognized grounds for an excused absence at the Rutgers School of Nursing (see <u>Rutgers listing of religious observances</u>). A religious accommodation is any adjustment to the work and/or academic environment that allows individuals to practice their religion. Religious accommodation must be approved in advance; students are advised to provide timely notification to instructors about necessary absences for religious observances.

#### Request for religious accommodation can be made using the School of Nursing <u>Religious</u> <u>Accommodation Request Form</u>.

**Makeup**: Students absent from an examination because of required religious observance will be given an opportunity to make up the examination without penalty. Students are responsible for making up the work or exams missed due to an accommodation according to an agreed-upon schedule.
